

NOAH'S ARK ZOO FARM: NO FRIEND OF THE ANIMALS!

NOAH'S ARK ZOO FARM EXPOSED:

- * Tiger cub Tumkur brought out to be displayed to public right up until his death. Visitors concerned to see him twitching and shaking.
- * Excess animals killed over winter to save on feed costs.
- * BIAZA (zoo trade body) membership rebuked for 'bringing the organisation into disrepute'.
- * Despite the exposé, Noah's Ark Zoo Farm has taken in lion cubs in February 2010 and in May 2010 was granted planning permission for an elephant enclosure.
- * North Somerset Council carried out a full investigation after the exposé and have since added seven new conditions to the zoo's licence, including:
 - * No non-domesticated animals to be brought out of enclosures for public displays
 - * Routine monthly vet visits
 - * Vet records kept up to date
 - * Post mortems to be carried whenever a non-domesticated animal dies and council to be notified

95% of animals in UK zoos are not endangered. Over 70% of elephants in European zoos are wild caught.
